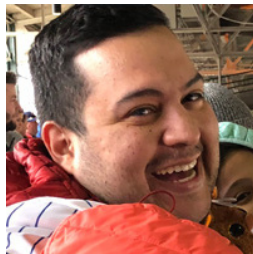

Peirce 2020 Local School Council Voting Information

There are 10 parent and 3 community members running for Peirce's LSC to fill 6 parent and 2 community representative positions. Staff and teacher LSC roles are voted on by teachers and staff only. Parent and community voters will select no more than 5 candidates they'd like to serve for a two year term. These 5 votes can be split between the parent and community candidates in any combination, including all five votes going to parent candidates.

How to Vote:

All in-person voting will require 2 forms of identification. Voters will be subjected to health protocols including masking and social distancing. Individuals with disabilities or health concerns will have access to curbside voting. Proof of citizenship not required to vote. Mail-in ballots will be sent to addresses on file in Aspen. Peirce Parent/Guardian Voting Options:

1. Vote in-person at Peirce on November 18th between 7am - 7pm.
2. Submit your ballot by mail. Ballots must be received by November 18 at 7:00pm.
3. Drop off your mail-in ballot at Peirce. This can be done any day through November 18 at 7:00pm.

To vote in-person parents/guardian will need 2 IDs. At least one must confirm child's enrollment at CPS. No ID is required for mail-in ballot drop-offs.

Community Member Voting:

Community members living within Peirce boundaries will vote in-person only at Peirce on November 18.

To vote in-person community members will need 2 IDs. At least one must confirm proof of residency (e.g. utility bill).
